ORDINANCE OF MASTER OF PHARMACY
(2 year Post Graduate Degree Course)

- 1) The post Graduate degree in Pharmacy of 2 year (4 Semesters) duration hereinafter called 2 year post Graduate course shall be designated in short as M. Pharm. The duration of M.Pharm. Course shall spread over a period of two years consisting of four semesters named below:
 - (i) M.Pharm. I Semester
 - (ii) M.Pharm II Semester
 - (iii) M.Pharm III Semester
 - (iv) M.Pharm IV SemesterEach semester shall spread over for not less than sixteen weeks.
- 2) For admission to M. Pharm Ist year, Ist semester, incumbent must pass B. Pharm from UGC recognized University/College/ Institution recognized by the AICTE or approved by the equivalent committee of M.J.P. Rohilkhand University scoring not less than 55% marks in B. Pharm (50% for SC and ST candidate). Preference will be given to GPAT qualified candidate.
- 3) There shall be four end-semester examinations leading to degree of master of Pharmaceutical Sciences.
M. Pharm Ist Year: M.Pharm Ist semester
M.pharm IInd semester
M. Pharm IInd Year: M.Pharm IIIrd semester
M.Pharm IVth semester
- 4) No student shall be permitted to appear in end semester examination unless he/she has regularly attended upto minimum of 75% classes in aggregate of all subjects. The University may however, condone not more than 10% shortage in attendance in each subject for any of the following reasons: Participation in campus, inter university/state level games, extra-curricular activities at university/state level.
- 5) The candidate who fails to pass in end semester examinations shall appear in back paper examinations which will be held along with end semester examinations of next batch. Student will have to pass all papers (theory, practical, workshop) for appearing in final examination of Dissertation work.
- 6) The examinee who fails in more than five (in total of first year) papers in M.Pharm Ist and IInd semester will be given a provision to take re-admission with full fee in the failing semester. Notwithstanding anything contained in the ordinances to the contrary a student may complete the entire course in not more than 4 academic years, starting from the year of his/her admission to the course. Failure to complete the course in 4 years shall render the student unfit for the course and his/her admission shall automatically cancel at the end of four academic years without any notice.
- 7) Sessional Examination in each paper (theory and Practical) shall contribute 30% of the total marks allotted to the paper. The annual examination shall contribute the remaining 70%.

- 8) The department shall conduct two sessional examinations in each theory subject and best of one of it shall contribute 50% weightage of marks. The rest 50% weightage shall be granted to performance in seminar. Assessment in practical sessional examination shall be based on day to day performance, Viva-voce and practical performance.
- 9) In order to fill the application for the admission to the examination, the candidate shall fulfill the norms of study in all the practical and theory classes as prescribed in the syllabus. He/She must also fulfill the norms of sessional examination and other tests if conducted during the academic year.
- 10) In order to be declared successful in M. Pharm examination a candidate shall have to clear all norms of attendance, sessional examinations, seminars, workshop, end semester examination and any other requirement as laid down by the department / University.
- 11) In order to pass an examination an examinee shall obtain.
 - (a) Not less than 50% in each theory paper including the marks obtained in sessional examination.
 - (b) Not less than 50% marks in each practical paper including the marks obtained in sessional practical examination.
- 12) For the purpose of passing an examination, the theory & practical of subject shall be considered as separate papers and an examinee shall have to pass theory and practical separately.
- 13) A maximum of five (05) grace marks may be awarded to an examinee in an examination in maximum of two subjects.
- 14) Examinee declared successful in both M. Pharm. examinations shall be placed in divisions on the basis of the aggregate of marks obtained in the examination of both years as given below.

75% or more marks in subject	Passed with distinction in the Subject
60% or more in aggregate	Passed in I st division
50% or more but less than 60% in aggregate	Passed in II nd division
- 15) A student who fails to pay fees or any other outstanding dues or return library books shall not be allowed to appear in University examination.
- 16) All other rules implemented by the University from time to time shall be applicable to M. Pharm. students.
- 17) The tuition fees for the M. Pharm. course will be 50,000/per semester.
