## **DEAN STUDENTS’ WELFARE OFFICE**

### **Administrative Functions and Responsibilities**

The office of the DSW co-ordinates and is associated with a number of activities related to the welfare of students. For this purpose, the Dean Students’ Welfare, along with a team of Assistant DSWs, delivers the responsibilities entrusted to this office.

The role and responsibilities of DSW office are listed as follows:

- The DSW office co-ordinates and arranges the disbursement of all financial aids, scholarships, stipends etc. to the students.
- The DSW. office makes arrangements with Railway authorities for the issue of railway concessions to students during vacations for educational tours, and for students’ participation in extracurricular activities and sports.
- The DSW actively Coordinates for Annual Convocation/programme in an appropriate manner. The DSW. office issues gold medals to the toppers of various courses of the university.
- The DSW office monitors the functioning of the University Health Centre.
- The DSW office is actively associated in the running/implementation of all student activities in consultation with the In-Charge of the section concerned.
- The DSW office organizes various camps for the students.
- The DSW coordinates the proper functioning of the University Grievance cell. The DSW is also Chairman of the Committee.
- The DSW monitors the functioning of the University Health Service and indoor treatment of students in consultation with the Doctor and the Warden of the Halls of residence concerned.
- The DSW works for the welfare of the students as prescribed in the Regulations and also as directed by State Government as well as the Vice-Chancellor from time to time.

**FELLOWSHIPS/SCHOLARSHIPS / AID TO STUDENTS / FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, ETC.**

## **NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Scholarships are awarded by the Director of Education, Allahabad, out of the quota fixed by the Government to students on the basis of merit.

### **BACKWARD CLASS SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarships of different rates are awarded to students belonging to the Backward and other Backward Classes by a Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of DSW.

### **SCHEDULED CASTE SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarships of different rates in different classes are awarded to students belonging to Scheduled Caste by a Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of DSW.

### **U.G.C. RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS**

U.G.C. Junior Research Fellowship such as Fellowship on any given time basis (in the subject concerned as also Fellowship in the concerned Department)

### **CSIR RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP**

Junior and Senior Research Fellowships are awarded by the CSIR directly to those who qualify CSIR-UGC Joint National Eligibility Test.

### **GOVERNMENT MERIT CUM MEANS SCHOLARSHIP**

- i) Financial assistance is given to pursue degree and/or postgraduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution. Maintenance allowance is credited to the student's account. The course fee is paid by the State Department directly to the institute concerned.
- ii) Students who get admission to a college to pursue technical/professional courses, on the basis of a competitive examination, are eligible for the scholarship.
- iii) Students who get admission in technical/professional courses without facing any competitive examination are also eligible for scholarship. However, such students should not have less than 50% marks at higher secondary/graduation level. Selection of these students is done strictly on merit basis.
- iv) Continuation of the scholarship in subsequent years can depend on successful completion of the course during the preceding year.
- v) A scholarship holder under this scheme can not avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the course.

### **U.P. GOVERNMENT POSTMATIC AND FEE REIMBURSEMENT**

This is given to students of University belonging to OBC/SC/ST/General/Minority community of U.P. State, pursuing courses in the University, whose parents' annual income does not exceed Rs. 2 Lakhs.

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- 3) A scholarship holder under this scheme can not avail any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the course.
