

# DIRECTORATE OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Internationalization of higher education develops an open perspective, establishes open channel communication, facilitates understanding and encourages people to broader their exposure and knowledge. In light of globalization in the 21st

century business are seeking employees with skills that would make them more competitive in the international arena. Hence the graduates of universities need to have the ability to interact with people from other cultures & different backgrounds to be successful at the international level. They are required to work with multicultural teams and speak other languages. Universities must prepare their students for such a globalized environment, thus enabling their graduates to be more acceptable and employable in national and international market.

To enrich academic, research and cultural diversity at international level.

Internationalization of the campus aims at capacity building of students, young researchers, scientists and faculty members of universities of developing countries working in the field of Information Technology, Engineering, Pharmacy, Natural Sciences, Humanities, Management, Social Sciences, Education, Law, Economics, History, and Arts to make a bond between MJP Rohilkhand University (MJPRU) and universities of other countries.

In the view of implementation of Internationalization, NEP 2020 and to attain the goal of global quality standards arise the necessity to establish the directorate of International relations at MJPRU.

The MJPRU, Bareilly will be partnered with leading universities/institutions of developing countries to launch its different international joint programs. Official authorities of both the universities will sign the MoU formalizing a mutual goal to build diverse and sustainable partnerships. The directorate of international student relations will pave the way for students and academic king to partner on project addressing some of the most important issues affecting India and global communities. Open to all disciplines will enable students to gain a global qualification from both the universities/institutions. The collaborations will lead to strong industry linkages, colleges, universities and research institutes of national and international repute. It will help in developing people to people links. The prominent research institutes, industry and colleges around MJPRU will be approached to join as an associate and industry partners so MJPRU can continue to expand internationally relevant research in diverse fields. With generous opportunities MJPRU will enable students from India and other developing countries to take advantage of world class facilities and resources to gain exposure to culturally diverse research and academic networks.

We wish to make MJPRU a key player in the higher education internationally and we are committed to building a strong culture of collaboration with one of the best institutions globally.

## 2. OBJECTIVES OF THE DIRECTORATE

- To develop international relationships with Universities and Higher Education Institutions of different countries.
- To collaborate with Higher Education Institutions (Government or Private) of national repute institution at international level.
- To supervise and sustain the international activities of the MJP Rohilkhand University.

- To create the awareness of the government schemes/fellowships for the faculty members and students at the National and International level..
- To facilitate research collaborations, exchange of research ideas, students and culture exchange programs.
- Researchers, scientists and students from various countries will be given opportunity to conduct their research work (full or partial) in the university under the guidance / joint supervision of MJPRU faculty members to improve their own research capabilities & vice-versa.

The above objectives are not limited and can be extended as and when required in the best interest of university.

#### 3. FUNCTIONING OF THE DIRECTORATE

- Directorate will create a lucid and informative website devoted to fulfill the objectives of the directorate.
- Directorate will organize, supervise and sustain the international workshops/conferences with the collaboration of different departments/ institutes of the MJPRU.
- Directorate will strive to increase the visibility of the international community and promote educational, research programs and cultural exchange.
- Directorate will advocate on behalf of our populations on campus, in the community, and with relevant government agencies.
- Directorate will pave the path for MoU between MJPRU and International Institutions.
- Directorate will provide guidance and counseling to international students in the view of change environment and culture.
- Directorate will provide the guidelines for the admissions to the international students and research scholars with the coordination of directorate of research & admission cell.
- Directorate will organize orientation programs for the international students immediately after their admissions at MJPRU.
- Directorate will inform the international students about the academic rules, regulations and about the Law of India.
- Directorate will organize social events for coalescing domestic and international students.

- Directorate will organize cultural trips to nearby destinations.
- Directorate will coordinate with the University to provide multilingual courses.
- Directorate will facilitate International Alumni Relations.
- Directorate will facilitate student, faculty & officers exchange.
- Directorate will facilitate working in quality with multinational companies.

## 4. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE DIRECTORATE

The office bearer of the directorate will be designated as Director, Associate Director and Assistant Director. The Director and all the office bearer of the Directorate will be appointed by the Honorable Vice Chancellor of MJPRU, Bareilly and can be changed at any time by the Honorable Vice Chancellor. The numbers of the Associate directors and Assistant Directors will be decided by the Honorable Vice Chancellor. An advisory board shall be constituted by the Director with approval from the Vice-Chancellor.

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# 6. DIFFERENT KIND OF PROGRAMS

# i. Student Exchange Program

Today's higher education institutions must be more than just a place to get a degree. In order to recruit students in highly competitive markets, Colleges and universities must create welcoming and dynamic campus environment and foster the kind of educational opportunities that translate into success beyond the college years.

There are four benefits of bringing foreign students to study at MJPRU, Bareilly.

- International students foster a diverse campus environment.
- International students enrich learning environment with cultural perspectives.
- Recruitment of international students attracts the Best of the Best.
- International students create significant income opportunities.

To be in world university rankings list MJPRU will encourage foreign students to study at MJPRU. Students exchange programs will be initiated in different fields of Natural Sciences, Engineering, Pharmacy, Hotel management, Humanities, Social Sciences and Management. Under this program students will have exposure to visit the leading institutes and industry of their fields. Students will have exposure to understand the latest technology hands on experience in laboratories and different culture.

There will be both short-term and long-term exchange programs for students during which the Conferences, workshops, seminars, discussion, Internships and visit to industry and institutes/universities will be organized in India and abroad.

To focus on attracting international students through overseas entrance exams and scholarship exams will be held by MJPRU in different countries in Asian and African continents for admission to the university UG, PG and Ph.D. programs.

World rankings are primarily based on six indicators: Academic reputation, Employer reputation, Student faculty ratio, Infrastructure, Citations per faculty,

International faculty and student ratio. Around 40% weightage in the rankings is about perception of the university its campus and infrastructure. More than the perception, universities are judged on their strength of international students, international faculty and academic reputation and also on number of scholarships awarded to international students.



An exchange program allows students from two universities in two different countries to spend a semester or two in the other institution while taking courses. Students from the "home university" become visiting students in the "host university" for a limited time to increase their international exposure. This arrangement is made possible by a student exchange agreement between the two universities.

To increase research collaboration between two universities a graduate student exchange program is a useful tool. In such a program for example graduate students may spend a period in the host university possibly using the facilities or equipments of the host university not available at the home university/institution. In the same period it is also possible for graduate students to take courses in the host university not offered in the home university in the same period.

#### ii. Faculty exchange Program

The university campus internationalization depends mostly on faculty interest, involvement and commitment to incorporate international substance to their courses and to establish new programs with an international approach. Faculty members who will participate in foreign exchange programs try to infuse their international experience through establishing comprehensive campus internationalization.

Short term international exchange program for faculty from foreign countries will help to internationalize the MJPRU campus through teaching, research and services. The different services include an extracurricular program to include an international and intercultural dimension, greater recruitment of international students, study abroad programs, internationalized curriculum, distance education and combination of partnerships abroad, research and scholarly collaboration.

This program will further expose the significance of faculty international development on the assimilation of global education and international culture in to their research and teaching.

Faculty members will be encouraged to increase their efforts to study and teach overseas as more people recognize the significance of faculty international experience on students. Increased number of international students and visitors to MJPRU will contribute effectively to the cross cultural understanding. Thus faculty members must receive direct knowledge through faculty exchange programs to understand other cultures and participate in campus internationalization.

#### **International Research Exchange**

To raise the bar on international collaborations, to boost the teaching and research quality MJPRU will be the university where the scholars pursue their passions

through rigorous academics, a flexible curriculum and innovative research programs. Research scientists and students from developing countries will be given opportunity to conduct their research work (partial or full) in the university under the guidance of MJPRU faculty members to improve their own research capabilities. This will foster scientific and technology related exchange/ cooperation between MJPRU and universities in other countries.



## 7. FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

A separate account of DIR will be maintained in the university as per the approval of the Vice-Chancellor as per university rules.

## 8. STATUTORY AND LEGAL STATUS

The Uttar Pradesh University Act, 1973 as well as M.J.P. Rohilkhand University First Statutes also states that; The University has a duty to co-operate and collaborate with other Universities and authorities in such manner and for such purpose as the university may determine. DIR will be a constituent entity of the University for academic and administrative purposes. The staff posted/transferred in DIR will work under the administrative control of the Director of DIR and the Director will directly report to the Vice-Chancellor.

## 9. MODUS OPERANDI

- In the university, all the offers and proposals under international relations will be routed and executed by the DIR with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor.
- Affiliated/constituent Colleges and institutions, desirous of establishing the international relation unit in their campuses, may do so with the prior approval of University authority.

## 10. CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- The University reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations of DIR any time with the permission of the Vice-Chancellor.
- The clause relating to dispute resolution should be mentioned in Memorandum
  of understanding to be entered with a party while undertaking Collaborations
  and cooperation with DIR. In case of mentioned and non-mentioned the clause,
  and in all other cases, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final and
  binding on all the concerned parties.
