Ordinance

1. Eligibility:

1.1 **Admission Criteria:** Merit shall be calculated by taking percentage of marks in graduation plus performance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview having a maximum of 20 marks.

1.2 **Qualifying examination:** The eligibility condition for admission to P.G. Diploma in mass communication and electronic journalism is that the candidate should have passed the qualifying examination. i.e. graduation with 45% marks in any discipline. There shall be relaxation of 5% of marks for SC/ST candidates.

1.3 **Marks:** Candidates shall be admitted on their overall merit for respective social categories as per rules of UGC and UP Government and the number of seats available.

2. Duration of Course:

The duration of the course leading to P.G. Diploma in mass communication and electronic journalism shall be one year / two semesters.

3. **Medium of Instruction:** Hindi and English.

4. **Curriculum:** Attached a copy of curriculum.

5. **Attendance: 75% in theory and 80% in practical's.**

6. Internal Assessment:

6.1 In every theory paper 40 marks are assigned for internal test and class activities like group discussion, seminar and assignments.

8. **Schedule of Examination:** First Semester examination will be conducted in Nov. and Second Semester in April or as decided by M.J.P. Rohilkhand University, Bareilly.

9. **Promotion:**

(a) After completion of theory papers in first semester, there will be a break of not exceeding one week to start the second semester

(b) In case a student fails in first semester or could not appear in theory exam of this semester but has completed attendance as well as undergone prescribed sessional activities, practical's and internal tests may be allowed to appear within two years as year back/ ex-student in next session. The internal marks received in previous session shall be carried over.

(c) Likewise if the student stagnates in second semester by not getting passing marks or could not appear in final semester but has completed required attendance as well as undergone prescribed sessional activities, practicals and internal tests may be allowed to appear with in two year as year-back/ex student in the session. The internal marks received in previous session shall be carried over.

(d) In case of any obscurity the rules of university shall prevail.

10. **Back paper/ improvement :**

A student shall be permitted back/ improvement in only one paper in either semester whenever the examination of that semester is conducted.

11. **Re –admission :** a student shall be permitted to complete the course with in two years.
