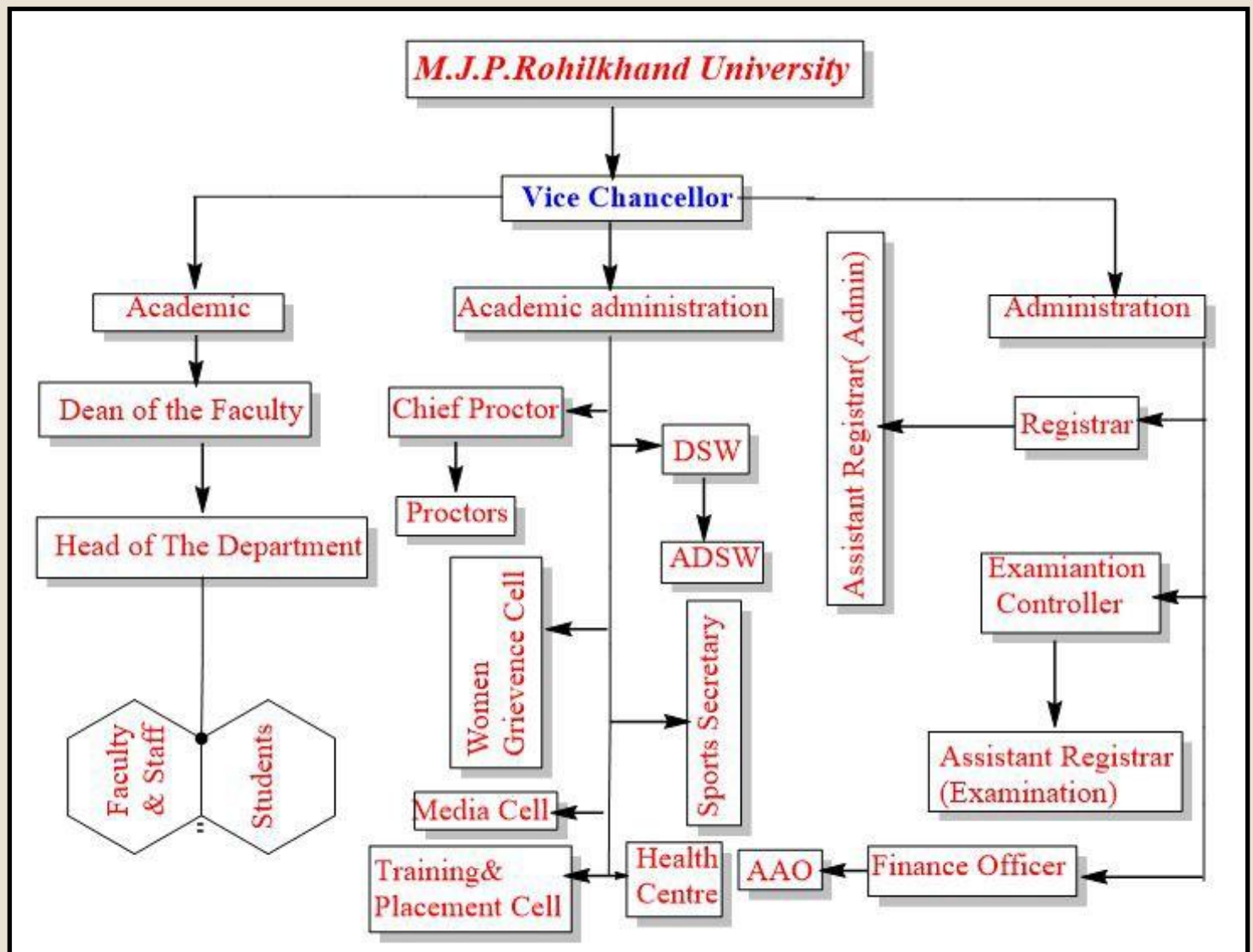
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About MJP Rohilkhand University

The Procedure of Admission:

1. Admission to B. Tech II Year (Lateral entry) (all branches), B. Pharm. I Year, B. Pharm. II Year (Lateral entry) and MCA shall be done through UPCET-2021.
2. Admission to B. Tech I Year (all branches) shall be based on JEE (mains) score.
3. Candidates are advised to be in touch with the University website www.mjpru.ac.in or the NTA website www.nta.ac.in, <https://upcet.nta.nic.in> and <https://jeemain.nta.nic.in> for updates in this regard.
4. The admission to various M.Sc. programs shall be based on University Entrance Examination. The candidates are directed to Check the university website www.mjpru.ac.in regularly for updates.

Eligibility Conditions

(a) Educational qualification for B.Tech./B. Pharm.:

A candidate passed 10+2 examination (intermediate) with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry shall be eligible for admission to first semester of Bachelor of Technology course and candidates appearing in or passed the same examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics shall be eligible for admission to the First semester of Bachelor of Pharmacy. The candidate must produce the mark sheet at the time of admission to prove their eligibility otherwise their claim for the seat shall not entertained.

(b) Educational qualification for B.Tech. II Year (lateral entry):

A candidate passed Diploma in relevant branch of Engineering & Technology. The candidate must produce the mark sheet at the time of admission to prove their eligibility otherwise their claim for the seat shall not entertained.

(c) Educational qualification for B. Pharm. II Year (lateral entry):

A candidate passed Diploma in Pharmacy. The candidate must produce the mark sheet at the time of admission to prove their eligibility otherwise their claim for the seat shall not entertained.

(d) Educational qualification for MCA I Year:

A candidate passed the graduation with Mathematics as one of the subjects at 10+2 or UG level. The candidate must produce the mark sheet at the time of admission to prove their eligibility otherwise their claim for the seat shall not be entertained.

(e) Educational qualification for M.Sc. I Year:

A candidate passed Graduation (B.Sc.) with 45% marks for general and OBC category and passed for SC Category having Physics or Chemistry or Mathematics as one of the subjects in B. Sc. III Year for admission to M.Sc. (physics) or M. Sc. (Chemistry) or M. Sc. (Mathematics) respectively.

Reservations:

- i. The reservation of seats shall be as per the rules of U.P. State Government for different categories.
- ii. The reservation benefits shall be extended only to residents of Uttar Pradesh. Other state residents are not entitled to get the benefit of reservation.
- iii. Candidates applying under reserved categories shall be required to submit the certificate for the relevant category. For OBC candidates the certificate must not be older than three years with mention of non-creamy layer on the certificate.
- iv. The certificate must be issued from the competent authority as per U.P. Government norms.
