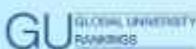

Specialized zones for shot put and javelin throw are available, providing safe and professional infrastructure for field athletics.



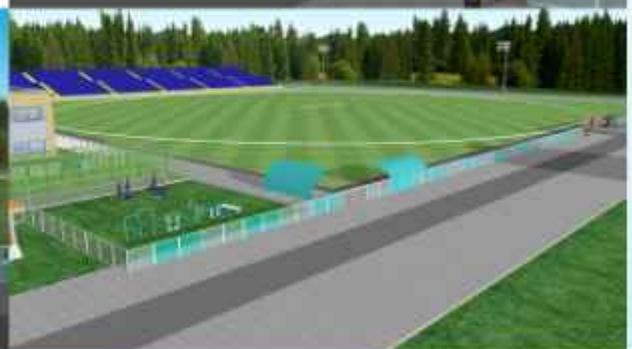

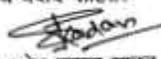

### Charges and fees

#### Charges for Sports Tournament and Events:

Outdoor Ground	₹ 5000/- Per day
Multipurpose Hall & Table Tennis Hall	₹ 5000/- Per day (Single Hall)

#### Charges for Individual:

Outdoor Ground Fees	₹ 500/- Per Month
Badminton Court Fees	₹ 750/- Per Month (1 hrs per day)
Table Tennis Court Fees	₹ 500/- Per Month (1 hrs per day)
Shooting Range Fees	₹ 1000/- Per Month
GYM Fees (For Campus Staff & Students)	₹ 1100/- Six Months
GYM Fees (For Campus Staff & Students)	₹ 2100/- Per Year

- Sports fees as decided by the Executive Council of the University will be collected from the student taking admission /re-admission in degree streams of affiliated colleges of the University. Besides that, the colleges desirous of participating in any Intercollegiate Tournaments/Championships shall have to pay a registration fee as decided by the Sports Council from time to time.
- All the sports fees and registration fees shall be paid at the Cash Counter of the Administrative Building.
- College/ Institution will have to spend the college share of money collected from the students for deputing teams for Intercollegiate Tournaments/Championships organized by the Sports Council in that year only.

## SPORTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

### Incentives and Support for Sportsperson :

#### Academic Relaxation:

- Authorized absence from classes for participation in university-approved sports events (Inter-Collegiate, Inter-University, National, International) as per University attendance policy.
- Provisions for special examinations or remedial classes for academic work missed due to sports commitments, as per academic regulations.
- However, athletes whose academic grades regularly decline due to nonstudy are not allowed to represent the university until their grades improve.
- Students participating in Intercollegiate, Interuniversity, State, National, and International level Sports & Games Tournaments/Championships will be able to appear separately for their semester exams, if they clash with or close to the dates of the Competition/ Tournaments.

#### Financial Support:

- Reimbursement of travel, daily allowance (TA/DA), lodging, and boarding expenses for officially approved tours and tournaments as per university norms.
- Provision of sports kits and equipment as deemed necessary.
- The university will provide the uniform to the players, coaches, and other supporting staff.

#### Awards and Recognition :

Felicitating and awarding medal winners and outstanding sportspersons at university, zonal, national, and international levels.

Providing scholarships or concessions to exceptionally talented and performing athletes, subject to the availability of funds.

1.1) To motivate the position holders, the University will reward the players at the end of the session as per the following norms:

- i. Best sports person, male and female (One trophy and ₹10,000 cash).
- ii. Cash prizes will be given to the position holders, Players of the team/individual events as mentioned below.
- iii. Along with the Cash prizes Public Honor and Letter of Appreciation will also be provided.

## SPORTS RULES AND REGULATIONS

### Medical Care & Insurance :

- Provision for basic first aid and immediate medical attention during training and competitions.
- Consideration for a Group/Individual Accident Insurance Scheme for sportspersons taking part in inter-university competitions.
- Facilitating access to sports medicine and physiotherapy support where possible.

### Trophies and Certificates:

- The Sports Council of the University shall provide the trophies to winner and runners-up teams. The College receiving running trophies shall hold themselves responsible for the safe custody of the trophies received. All the trophies of Inter-Collegiate Tournament shall be running (rolling) trophies.
- There shall be one replica along with the certificates for each championship trophy given by the organizing secretary, the replica shall be retained permanently by the winning college and shall be the property of the winning college.
- The college holding any of the rolling trophies shall return the same to the Secretary, Sports Council at its own cost in the month of June every year.
- A certificate of merit signed by the Secretary, Sports Council shall be awarded to the individual member of the winner and Runners – up team in team games, weight lifting and individual athletic championship and to individuals securing first and second places in athletics/Best physique for Intercollegiate Tournaments. All the players participating Interuniversity tournaments/All India tournaments/ any national games are to be provided a certificate of merit signed by the Secretary and Vice-Chancellor of the University.
- Overall championship in Athletics shall be given in male and female categories separately. Best performer College(s) and Best sports talent of the year may be honored with special medals for both men and women events. This has to be decided by the committee on the basis of performance during that period.
- Best sport performance at zonal level shall be earmarked for each year.
- Sports Council with due approval of Chairman may provide sports equipment to any Affiliated Colleges on the basis of the competency of players of that event to promote them in the best interest of the University.
